





- Dragonflies can fly backwards
- Dragonflies were around before the dinosaurs.
- They are **insects** which mean they have 3 body parts (head, thorax and abdomen); they have 2 pairs of wings
- Dragonflies are invertebrates; they don't have a backbone
- Baby dragonflies are pond monsters; they live underwater and eat anything smaller than they are
- You can tell a dragonfly from a damselfly; a dragonfly has a
 thick body and its wings stay open when it lands, a damselfly has
 a thin body and it closes its wings when it lands
