Habitat loss



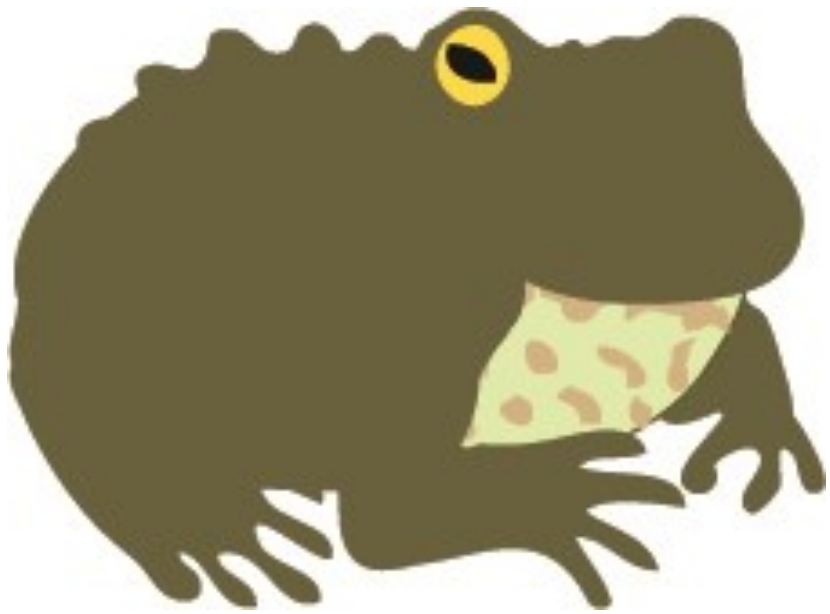
People want cheaper food and more houses, roads and supermarkets. This means ponds are being filled in and good habitat is lost.
